### Clear Lake Public Boat Launch

The new concrete ramp is open, with a more gradual slope than last year. It is to be used only between 9am and 1pm. Before launching, please note location of boulders on shore. Because of the gravel shoulders on the ramp, it is not possible to install the floating dock. Unless you are experienced with boat launching without a dock, it is recommended that you have a professional do this for you.

#### Signs Regarding Boat Launch

We have both 'Hours of Use' (9am to 1pm) and 'No Parking' signs installed at the ramp and additional 'No Parking' signs placed along the road at the public ramp and 200 metres either side of the launch.

## YMCA Camp Pine Crest Rezoning

In Summer 2014, the YMCA indicated it had initiated the process for an Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) Hearing on its Camp Pine Crest rezoning application, originally filed with the Township of Muskoka Lakes (TML) in November 2010.

In late March 2015, mediation was held that resulted in Minutes of Settlement (MOS) and TML By-law revision. The OMB subsequently agreed to the MOS, By-law and related site plan. Some details re the site plan were subsequently resolved. The site plan for Phase I adds 19,000 sq. ft. to the existing 48,000 sq. ft., including 7,000 sq. ft of new accommodation space.

In the MOS, the YMCA and TML made various commitments to CLPOA. The CLPOA Board and the Clear Lake Road Committee continue to work with the YMCA and TML to ensure their commitments are met. The TML has put \$25,000 in the 2016 budget for a road study and will be asking the YMCA to contribute. The CLPOA Board supports the study and YMCA participation.

## Water Quality Results from 2015 Testing

Thank you, Bob and Sharon Cleverdon for your time and effort collecting the lake water samples several times every season and submitting them to the Muskoka Lakes Association (MLA) Water Quality Initiative on our behalf. The cost for testing is approximately \$1,000 this year. With a \$30 discount for each CLPOA member who is also a member of MLA, it would benefit CLPOA if more of our members joined MLA.
